



End of Key Stage 2 (Year 6)

Year 6 pupils took the SATS (Statutory Assessment Tests) which assess their learning in reading, maths and grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS). Test results are reported as scaled scores in these subjects. In writing, teacher assessment is used, judging against National Curriculum performance descriptors.

Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard

We provide here an overview of our Key Stage 2 (KS2) results for the academic year 2024/25, which ended in July 2025. National Curriculum tests report results as 'scaled scores'. In order to meet the expected standard, children must achieve a scaled score of 100 or more in their tests. Children who achieve a scaled score of 110 and higher are considered to have a higher level of attainment.

In writing, pupils were teacher assessed as working at 'Greater depth.' In the GPS, maths and reading tests, pupils had to score a scaled score of 110 or above.

Phonics

The children in Year 1 take a Phonics Screening Check. If a child does not meet the threshold, they are expected to attempt the test again in Y2. In the table below are the results for EHPS in 2025 as well as the National and Hampshire average.
