



## Braishfield Primary School July 2018 Data summary (PROVISIONAL)

### End of Key Stage 2 (Year 6)

Year 6 pupils took the SATS (Statutory Assessment Tests) which assess their learning in reading, maths and grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS). Test results are reported as scaled scores in these subjects. In writing, teacher assessment is used, judging against National Curriculum performance descriptors.

In writing, pupils were teacher assessed as working at 'Greater depth.' In the GPS, maths and reading tests, pupils had to score a scaled score of 110 or above.

**Average progress scores**

This score demonstrates the progress our pupils make in KS2 judged against the progress made by pupils nationally from the same starting points as they enter Year 3. A positive score means that our pupils make more progress, on average, than those with similar prior attainment nationally, whereas a negative score shows that our children do not make as much progress across KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
